

NOTICE TO CITIZENS OF RICHLAND COUNTY: Pursuant to the South Carolina Eminent Domain Procedure Act, Section 28-2-70(c), Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, notice is hereby given that entry by personnel of and contracted by Richland County Government will be made in the area of the neighborhoods and greenways described below for such purposes as topographic surveys, subsurface exploration, environmental related studies and for the gathering of any other data necessary for the planning, design, property acquisition, and construction of the neighborhood improvement and greenway projects. Additional rights of way and/or easements may be needed to construct these projects.

The proposed projects are:

- Southeast Richland Neighborhood: This neighborhood improvement project includes construction of a roadway (Rabbit Run Connector) on new location from the intersection of Garners Ferry Road (US 76/378) and Century Oaks Lane north to a new intersection with Rabbit Run. The project may also include multi-use paths along Rabbit Run Connector, Rabbit Run and Lower Richland Boulevard.
- Broad River Neighborhood: This neighborhood improvement project may include streetscape design for Gibson Street, McRae Street, and River Drive, neighborhood sidewalk design for Brewer Street, Clement Road, Hart Street, Pearl Street and Wellesley Drive, and pedestrian pathway improvements to the Riverwalk.
- Three Rivers Greenway: This project includes constructing a greenway beginning at the Richland County line west of I-26 on Saluda River along the Saluda River to the existing Three Rivers Greenway on the Broad River.
- Gills Creek Greenway Section A: This project includes constructing a greenway beginning at Kilbourne Road south of Lake Katherine along Gills Creek to Bluff Road.
