

**NOTICE TO CITIZENS OF RICHLAND COUNTY:** Pursuant to the South Carolina Eminent Domain Procedure Act, Section 28-2-70(c), Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, notice is hereby given that entry by personnel of and contracted by Richland County Government will be made in the area of the roads described below for such purposes as topographic surveys, subsurface exploration, environmental related studies and for the gathering of any other data necessary for the planning, design, property acquisition, and construction of highway improvement projects.

- The proposed improvements for the following projects include widening the roadways and may include bicycle accommodations, curb, gutter and sidewalks. Additional rights of way may be needed to construct these projects.
  - Clemson Road Widening: This 2.0 mile widening project is located on Clemson Road (S-52) from Old Clemson Road to Sparkleberry Crossing.
  - Bluff Road Widening: This 2.5 mile widening project is located on Bluff Road (SC-48) from Rosewood Drive to South Beltline Boulevard.
  - Shop Road Widening: This 2.3 mile widening project is located on Shop Road (S-727) from George Rogers Boulevard to South Beltline Boulevard.
  - Atlas Road Widening: This 2.8 mile widening project is located on Atlas Road (S-50) from Bluff Road to Garners Ferry Road.
  - Pineview Road Widening: This 2.9 mile widening project is located on Pineview Road (S-1248/SC 768) from Bluff Road to Garners Ferry Road.
- Clemson Road and Sparkeberry Lane Intersection: This intersection improvement project is located along Clemson Road from Sparkleberry Crossing to the existing right turn lane from southbound Clemson Road onto westbound I-20 and along Sparkleberry Lane from Clemson Road to after North Donar Drive in Northeast Richland County. Additional rights of way may be needed to construct this project.

- Greene Street Phase II: Roadway improvements are proposed to Greene Street from Gadsden Street to Huger Street as well as the reconnection of Greene Street previously bisected by the Norfolk Southern and CSX railroads. Additional rights of way may be needed to construct this project.
