

NOTICE TO CITIZENS OF RICHLAND COUNTY: Pursuant to the South Carolina Eminent Domain Procedure Act, Section 28-2-70(c), Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, notice is hereby given that entry by personnel of and contracted by Richland County Government may be made in the area of the roads described below for such purposes as topographic surveys, subsurface exploration, environmental related studies and for the gathering of any other data necessary for the planning, design, property acquisition, and construction of the highway improvement project. Easements and/or additional rights of way may be needed to construct these pedestrian and intersection improvement projects.

Pedestrian Improvement Projects: The pedestrian improvement projects may include installing ADA compliant ramps, pedestrian signals, and crosswalks. The project locations are as follows: Assembly St at Calhoun St, Assembly St at Gervais St, Assembly St at Laurel St, Assembly St at Washington St, Blossom St at Saluda Ave, Elmwood Ave at Park St, Main St at Calhoun St, Main St at Laurel St, Rosewood Dr at Beltline Blvd, Rosewood Dr at Harden St, Rosewood Dr at Holly Rd, Rosewood Dr at Kilbourne Rd, Rosewood Dr at Marion St, Rosewood Dr at Ott Rd, Rosewood Dr at Pickens St, Two Notch Rd at Brickyard Rd, Two Notch Rd at Maingate Rd/Windsor Lake Blvd, and Two Notch Rd at Sparkleberry Ln.

Bull Street (SC 277/US 76) and Elmwood Avenue (US 76) Intersection: This intersection improvement project includes traffic signal modifications, modifications to exiting lanes and addition of travel lanes. The purpose of this project is to improve safety and traffic operations.
